What lesson does the Apostle give us in this epistle?



MONTH OF THE MOST HOLY NAME OF DESOS

In this time of Christmastide that this year is shortened to the 27th of the month because of the early Time of Septuagesima that begins on Sunday, *January* 28th. Normally it would last up to the Purification of Mary in the Time after Epiphany. Nevertheless in January we reflect on the Most Holy Name of Jesus as well as the Holy Family and later on Church Unity Octave between the feast of St. Peter's Chair and the Conversion of St. Paul. Let us then offer our Rosaries and daily sacrifices, crosses and submission to God's holy Will to relish this joyous time for soon we will be preparing for Lent in early February. Call upon the Blessed Mother of God to guard and guide us through this time of transition when the Joyful Mysteries are front and center from the Nativity of Our Lord

to the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary when the official time of Christmastide ends. Let us ask Mary to bring us safely to her divine Son, before His altar where we can receive Him Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity that we may grow in sanctifying grace to help us better focus on our mission as members of the Church Militant to apply our prayers, penances, sacrifices and self-mortifications for the conversion of those who
